Some sites can contain fake news or outdated details. For research projects, turn to your library for the most reliable resources.



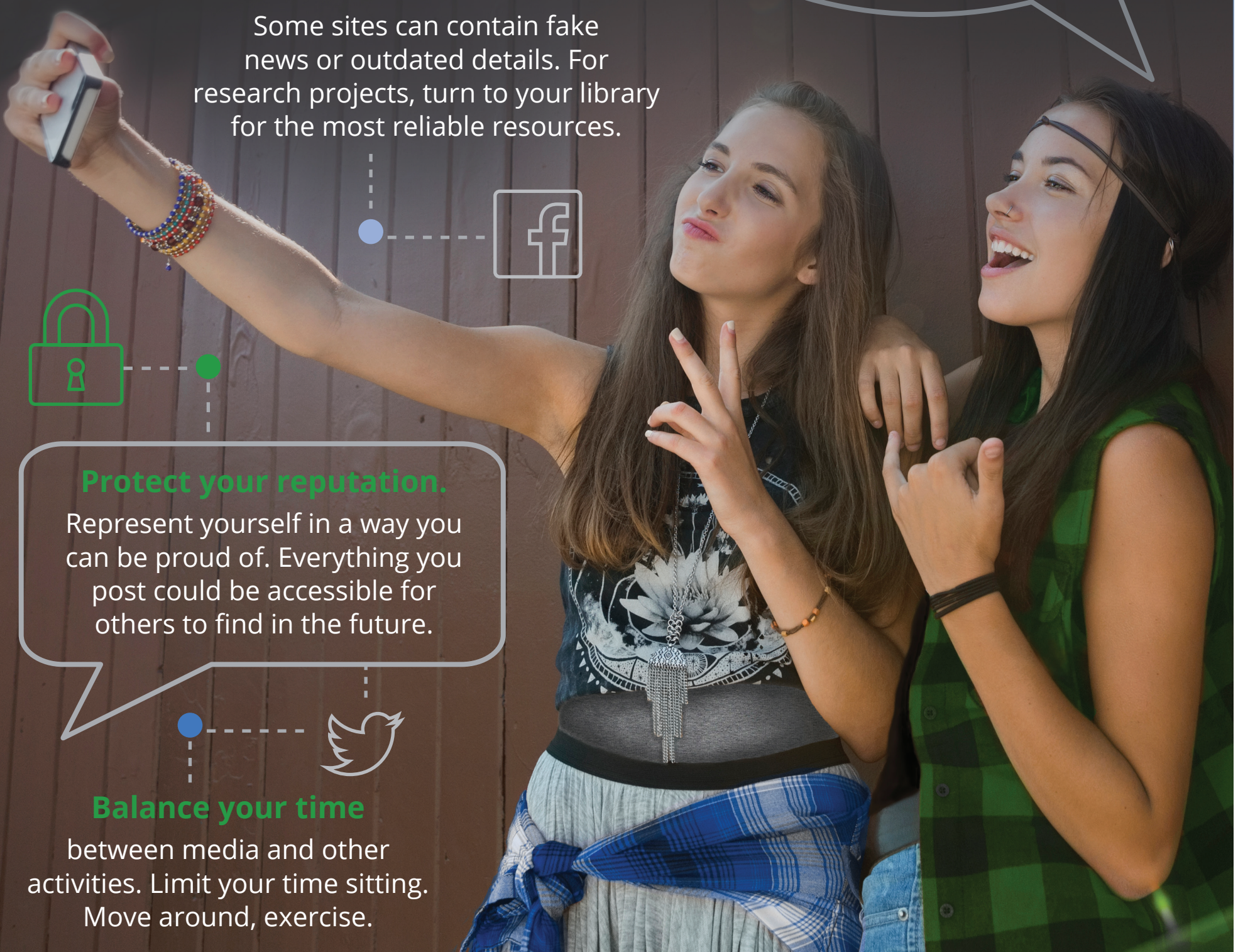
Protect your reputation.
