#### **Neonatal Abstinence Syndrome**

#### What We Know

- > Use or abuse of psychoactive substances—including prescription and nonprescription drugs, alcohol, and illicit drugs—by a woman during pregnancy places her newborn at risk for neonatal abstinence syndrome (NAS; also called neonatal withdrawal syndrome)<sup>(3,4,6,9,10,11,13,16)</sup>
- These substances cross the placenta and can cause dependency in the fetus, when fetal exposure to the substance(s) terminates at birth, the newborn is at risk for a spectrum of withdrawal manifestations (e.g., autonomic dysfunction, respiratory
